If you wish to cancel any booked sessions*, we require at least 48 hours' notice to enable you to 'bank' this session for use another day. Please note this date and make it clear in a message to a club manager on Famly when you wish to use it.

If *less than 48 hours' notice* is given, sessions are still *fully chargeable*.

However, if your child is poorly, you may bank individual sessions to use later in this Holiday Club or arrange to use at the next Holiday Club; please note that banked sessions must be used by the end of the subsequent Holiday Club or they will expire.

****If your child is collected after 5pm when we are closed, you will incur a late collection fee of £30 per half hour or part thereof as stated in the Parent Pack.**
